

#### Experiences and impulses:

In the last few days I have had the chance to think about the 2024 annual motto with others.



That broadened my perspective significantly. My first look at the new annual slogan was filled with enthusiasm. I read it as an inner guide that helps me to orient myself more clearly towards love in everyday situations and questions. "Great!" I thought.

Then I learned from others that we can also read this word as an (excessive) demand. Reading it as a demand to do everything out of love is discouraging. I can understand.

That got me thinking. Paul, who wrote this sentence at the end of his first letter to the Corinthians, had his reasons. He knew the Corinthians and he knew himself. He says of himself that he does not do the good that he wants to do (Rm 7:19). But Paul also sees that the church in Corinth is in the process of dismantling itself if they do not do the great things they can and do out of love (1 Cor 13).

What I notice about myself is that doing something with love makes a huge difference. It is much easier for the other person to accept my actions if I do what I do out of love. And I experience that when I do something out of love, my actions come very easily. This applies to things that I enjoy doing, but also to things that I find difficult. I can learn to love doing these activities too. This is a blessing for me because I save all the energy that I would otherwise need to overcome my inner resistance. A blessing!



But I still have the (over)demand thing in the back of my mind. How do I do what I love when there isn't enough? Love arises in relationships: with people, with God. Where I lack love, I lack loving relationships. The great thing is: God is always available to me with his unconditional love. God loves me through other people, but also directly. This is what I want to keep looking for this year with the annual motto.

And that's why I'm so happy about this annual motto. It helps me because love frees me more and more. Love is a child of freedom and vice versa (Gal 5:13). Let us not read this annual motto as a demand, but as an invitation to live in love and the freedom that grows from it.


## Farewell from the community
