Day Trip to Llandudno – Monday 16th September 2019

This is a full day visit to Llandudno, departing Fulwood Methodist Church at **9.00am** on **Monday 16th September 2019**. We expect to arrive in Llandudno at **11.00am** and the coach will drop us off outside the Merrion hotel, which is on the seafront, close to all the amenities.

The price for the trip is **£27.50** per person. If we have more than 22 people going on the trip we may be able to reduce this price to **£24** per person. A non refundable deposit of **£5** is required asap and full payment is due 1st week of September.

We plan to depart from Llandudno at **4.30pm**, returning back to Fulwood by **7.00pm**, dependent upon traffic conditions.
